BELL RINGERS NEEDED



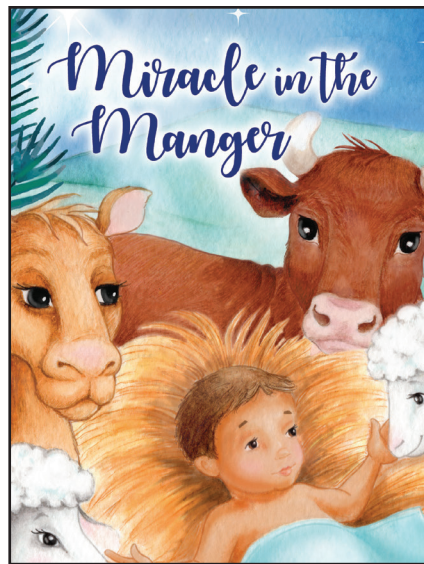

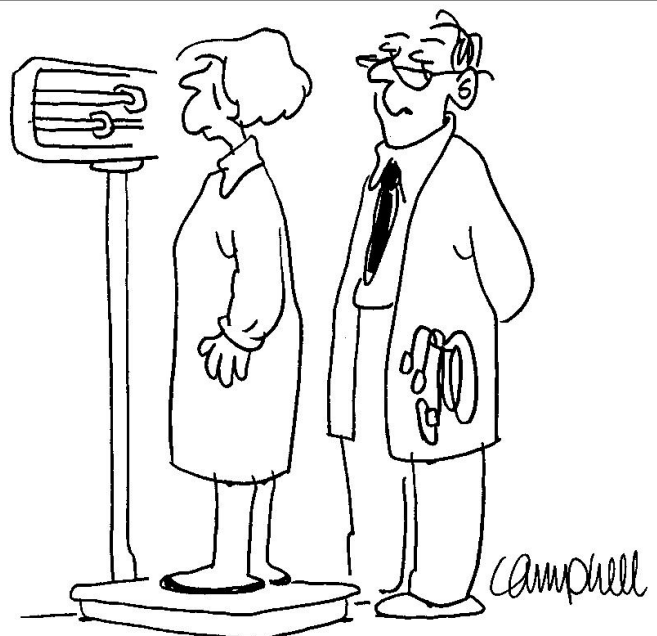
