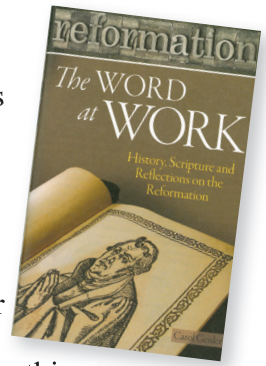
## 5-PART BIBLE STUDY

Join us for a **5-part Bible Study** from ELCA named *“Now Is the Time: A Study Guide for the ELCA Declaration to People of African Descent”* to help congregations wrestle with the meaning of the history and impact of slavery and systemic racism.
