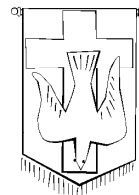

First Aid Kits are now in the Comfort Room located in the cabinet under the television. A white basket will contain a blood pressure monitor, gloves, hand sanitizer, and masks. The small clear box contains a Responder CPR Key Chain, 1 Ready Kit that contains pocket mask, bandage scissors, shaver, alcohol pads, 4" x 4" gauze pads and a pair of gloves. Also, tweezers, small scissors, pen and note pad, small flashlight, Neosporin ointment and chewable aspirin 81mg. 1 Non-Contact forehead thermometer and extra batteries. The large grey box contains a variety of bandages, dressings, wound wash, burn relief, blanket, and blue water proof pads. Kits supplied and purchased by Health Ministry.



If you have ever felt the power of prayer in your life, then you know what a difference it can make. That's why Zion's prayer chain gang is such an important part of our congregation's ministry!

The prayer chain gang is made up of people in our congregation who simply pray for others as the need arises. Anyone who needs prayer for a specific reason such as a health issue, upcoming surgery, etc. can request prayer for themselves or others. The recipient does not have to be a member of Zion.

The leader calls the first person on the list and shares the name of the person needing prayer and the reason for the request. That person calls the next one on the list and so on until everyone on the list has been notified. Then the praying begins! There are no meetings to attend. Prayer chain members just make one phone call and then pray.

Both ladies and gentlemen are welcome to join the group, and now is a good time!
