Worried About Your Child's Mental Health?

A child's mental health can be fragile. Children are very resilient, but they

too can suffer from anxiety, depression, stress or loss. For some kids, this shows up through acting out at school or at home. For others they become withdrawn and quiet. Others may become angry or easily frustrated. LCFS has specially trained professional therapists that deal specifically with children and their concerns. Together the counselor and child can discuss what's bothering them and come up with a plan and skills to navigate through challenging times. If you are worried about your child's well-being, consider a conversation with an LCFS counselor. Offices are located across the state and tele-health services are also available. 
A few changes to this year's sale! Due to Covid-19 the focus will be only on BASIC FAMILY NEEDS.

No electronics, toys, craft items, or seasonal decorations accepted!




