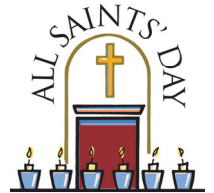

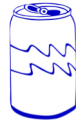
*Join us Tuesday mornings!*

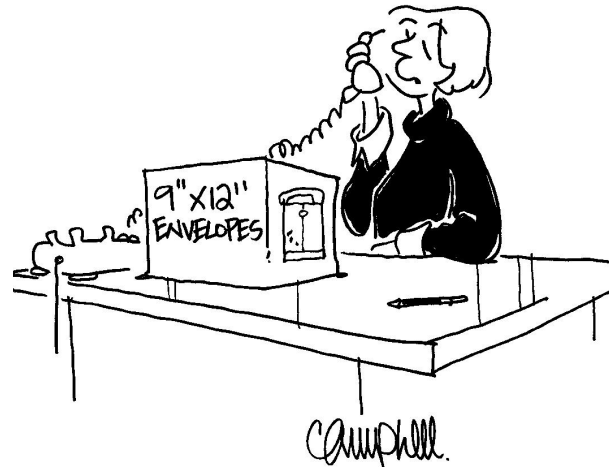
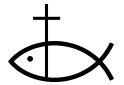
