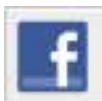

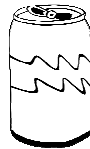


Just A Reminder – If you would like a pastoral visit when you are ill or hospitalized **please contact the office to make sure your visitation request is received!**



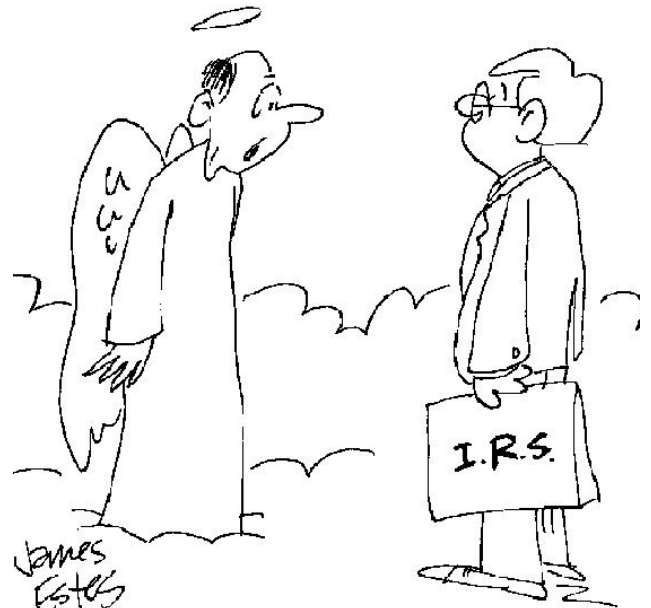
Please talk with your family members *now* about your wishes to inform the pastor in case your illness leaves you unable to do so.
