Each week there are between eight and 12 ladies who come to layer quilts, finish the quilts by sewing the edges, or making more tops, middles, or backs from donated fabric. Of course, we all enjoy the visiting that takes place during this time also. One morning we made 48 Personal Care Kits from items donated by Zion members ... more than we were able to send last year! *Thank you!*



We are again asking for your help by donating supplies for School Kits.

School supplies will be going on sale soon after school is out for the summer, so that would be a good time to purchase items needed. There will be tote provided for the donations under the bulletin board near the elevator, beginning June 1 through Sept. 2023.

The following items are needed:

- Four 70-80 sheet **SPIRAL** notebooks (280-300 sheets total) of wide or college-ruled paper approximately 8"x10.5"; no loose-leaf paper
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One pencil sharpener
- One pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One 2.5" eraser

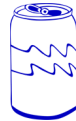

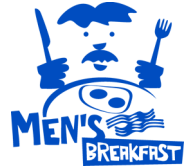

Bring your own snacks and blankets.

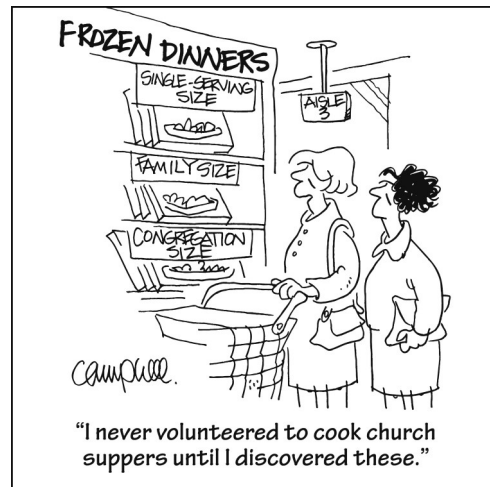
Wee Care will be doing Charlie's Red Barn July 13, 14 & 15
