PROCESSION OF LIGHT

HYMN #283 — O Come, All Ye Faithful

THE WORD

READER: On a long winter evening, we gather to proclaim the coming of the Light. Isaiah announces that the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. Paul reminds us that the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all. In the familiar account of Christ's birth, the evening sky is bright with the heavenly host singing, "Glory to God in the highest." Amid our broken world, we proclaim that the prince is born among us. God comes to us in human flesh – in Christ's body and blood – so that we may be bearers of divine light to all the world.

PEOPLE: Lord, hear the cries of your people. We stumble in the darkness of our sin. We fear what we cannot see. Our lives, hopes, joys, and our very beings have been consumed in blackness.

PASTOR: *Isaiah 59:9*: Therefore, justice is far from us, and the righteousness does not reach us; we wait for light, and lo! There is darkness, and for brightness, but we walk in gloom.

READER: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and without Him not one thing came into being. What has come into being in Him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light, but he came to testify to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.
