ANNE WILSON CONCERT - HOPE IN THE PARK

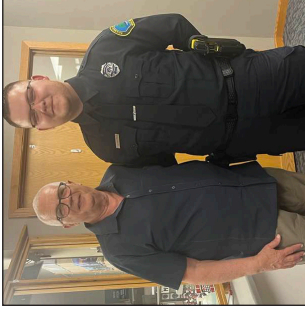
