KEEPING ZION'S MINISTRIES STRONG



ZLCW QUILTERS' KITS



Thank you to all those who have brought in items for Personal Care Kits for ZION's Mission Quilters. The need for them is great! We're in need of towels (52" long) and large bars of soap. We do not need toothpaste, nail clippers or combs. Thanks for your contributing to this important ministry. ZLCW Executive Board will be collecting items for School Kits to be sent to LWR in October. Education is one of the strongest tools a community has for breaking the cycle of poverty. Ensuring that girls attend school, especially in places where their access is deprioritized, has even stronger results. School Kits contain essential supplies to help children - and in some cases, adults - continue learning in the face of serious obstacles. That learning leads to a better life for them, their families and their communities. Visit Iwr.org/kits/school-kits/instructions for details.

School Kits:

• Give new items only, shows the greatest respect



and care for the recipient.

- Do not donate any items with religious symbols, messages, or ZION's name.
- Do not donate items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, armed forces, or camouflage.

School Kit items include:

- Four 70-80 sheet notebooks (280-300 sheets total) of wide-or college-ruled paper (8" x 10.5"); no loose-leaf paper.
- One 30 cm. ruler, or ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other.
- · One pencil sharpener.
- One pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well).
- Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band.
- Five black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink); secure together with a rubber band.
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons.
- · One 2.5 inch eraser.

There will be a container under the bulletin board by the elevator to put the items in. Thanks for donating to this worthwhile cause.
