

**Men's Bible Study** meets weekly at 8 AM at Shawano Cafe.

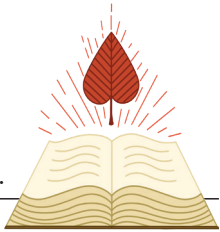
