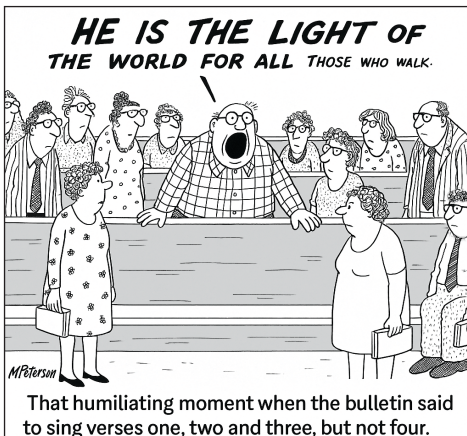
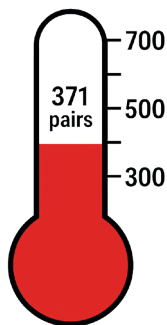
ZION Health Ministry is collecting **NEW SOCKS** in all sizes for women, men, boys, girls, and infants. Please help us fill our box during October.
