Personal care kit guidelines:

- ✓ Give new items only.
- ✓ Do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or ZION's name on any item.
- ✓ Do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.

Personal care kit items needed:

- ✓ One light-weight, dark-colored bath-size towel
- ✓ Two or three bath-size bars of soap (8-9 oz.) in original wrapping, no mini or hotel size bars.
- ✓ One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging
- ✓ One sturdy comb (no picks or fine-toothed combs)
- ✓ One metal nail clipper.
