PERSONAL CARE KITS

During Lent, ZION Lutheran Church Women (ZLCW) would like to provide this opportunity for all members to contribute to Personal Care Kits for Lutheran World Relief.

Personal care kit guidelines:

Give new items only. Do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages, or ZION's name on any item. Do not donate items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage. **LUTHERAN**

Personal care kit items needed:

One lightweight, dark-colored bath-size towel. Two or three bath-size bars of soap (8-9 oz.) in original wrapping, no mini or hotel-size bars. One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging. One sturdy comb (no picks or finetoothed combs). One metal nail clipper.

A plastic container is provided to place donated items in, which is locatedunder the bulletin board near the elevator.
