ZLCW SCHOOL KITS FOR LWR

ZLCW Board collects items for **School Kits for LWR**. School Kits contain supplies to help children and adults, continue learning in the face of obstacles. That learning leads to a better life for their families and communities.

Remember:

- Give new items only.
- No items with religious symbols, messages, or ZION's name.
- No decorations with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or camouflage.

Each School Kit includes:

- (4) 70-80 sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper approximately 8"x10.5"; no loose-leaf paper.
- (1) 30-centimeter ruler, or with centimeters and inches
- (1) pencil sharpener
- (1) pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors)
- (5) unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers;
- (5) black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink);
- (1) box of 16 or 24 crayons
- (1) 2.5-inch eraser

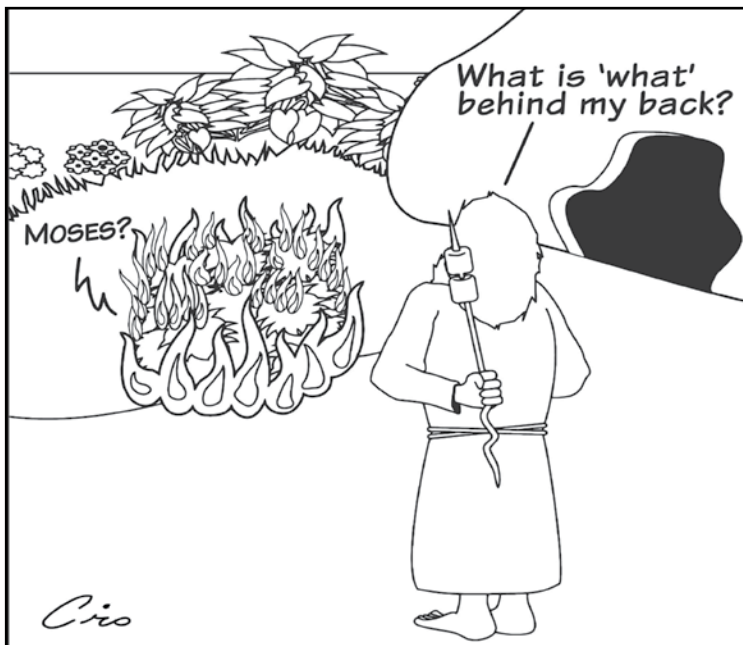

- (1) adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging
- (1) sturdy comb ... there are many types of hair texture, so no picks or fine-tooth combs; remove packaging.
- (1) metal nail clipper (file optional), remove packaging.
