CHOOSE A COLLEGE



reparing to transition from high school to college can be exciting and exhausting. By the time you're getting those acceptance letters in the mail, you've already worked so hard: You've kept a clean transcript, built an impressive résumé as an involved citizen, and written more essays than you ever thought possible.

And now, you're staring at one of the biggest decisions you'll make in your life. Add in the pressure from parents, advisors, and friends, and you've got a recipe for feeling like there is no right answer. Spoiler alert: There might not be one right answer. But there are still ways to move forward with the confidence that you're making a wise choice.

So how do you choose? How could you possibly consider every important part of a college, compare it to other impressive colleges, and know where you'd fit best, just based on a four-hour tour and a quick meal in the cafeteria?

You don't need to find the perfect school-but there are ways to find the perfect school for you.

Early in the application process, it's important to consider two major factors: academics and financial aid. Does the school have your major, and can you afford it?

While it's fine to remain open to possibilities when it comes to fields of study, narrowing your academic search to schools with strong programs that support your interests is a good start. It's also important to get a realistic picture of what your financial burden will look like. The last thing you want is to wake up from four years at your dream school to a decades-long nightmare of debt. Use debt calculators, including information about your earning potential in your desired field, to see what numbers make the most sense.

While money and majors are two big considerations, here

QUICK COMPARISON OF COLLEGE TYPES

PUBLIC UNIVERSITY

Lower costs for in-state tuition. Larger student bodies mean more opportunities but also more competition for resources. Faith groups and campus ministries provide a strong Christian community despite the secular setting.

PRIVATE CHRISTIAN COLLEGE

Higher tuition but often better aid packages. Smaller classes mean closer relationships with professors. There can be a strong emphasis on spiritual formation alongside academics, with faith integration in coursework and chapel requirements.

LIBERAL ARTS COLLEGE

Offers a well-rounded education rather than specific career training. This is good news for those still exploring interests. Classes intentionally connect different subjects (like faith and science or art and business). Usually have a smaller community feel.

RESEARCH UNIVERSITY

Larger institution with graduate programs and research opportunities. This means more major options and specialized programs. These are good for students who know their career path, especially if they need a strong pre-professional program (pre-med, pre-law).

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Most affordable option for the first two years. Live at home to save money while exploring interests. Credits transfer to four-year schools. Small but active Christian student organizations provide community.

TRADE/TECHNICAL SCHOOL

Career-focused training in specific fields. Shorter programs mean entering the workforce sooner. These provide a growing number of options in health care, business, and technology, which often include apprenticeships or hands-on experience.

are a few questions to ask when every school on your list feels like the best choice.

Can you handle the weather? This might seem like a silly question, but it's not. If you grew up in Southern California, are you ready to invest in winter gear to live in Minnesota? If you're from Michigan's Upper Peninsula, will you love the heat and humidity of Houston? Maybe you're ready for a change, but don't discount the effect of living in the middle of a climate you've never experienced before.

Do you want to be close enough to do laundry at home on the weekends, or are you looking for a more distant adventure? Consider whether you want a short drive or a long flight, a Sunday night dinner with a parent or a Sunday night phone call from them. While college is a time of independence in general, discerning what that independence looks like will help you draw the right physical boundaries around your collegiate choice.

What are the classes and curricula like? Weighing the differences between core and open curricula is worth considering. In a core curriculum approach, every student is required to take a certain number of classes from a broad range of disciplines. Some say this gives a well-rounded learning experience and can be helpful for students who aren't quite sure what they're most interested in studying as a major.

An open curriculum, in contrast, has a set number of credits a student needs to graduate but is much more flexible in terms of course options. Fans of this approach argue that students who have more autonomy in picking their courses will be more invested in their learning. An open curriculum is perfect for students who have a clear vision of what they want from their college academic experience. You'll find examples of great institutions that practice one or the other, but one might be better for you.

Are you going to vibe with the campus culture? Outside the classroom, nothing will color your college experience more than what an institution feels like. Do you want to join clubs or participate in Greek life? Is it important that faith is incorporated into your coursework? How do weekends covered in body paint and tailgating for the football team sound? Do you want to stand out in a smaller environment or blend in with the larger crowd? Determining what truly sounds like fun to you will go a long way to ensuring that you find success in college.

What kind of activities can you find off-campus? There's more to life than staying inside that campus-life bubble. Would you be more comfortable somewhere close to nature

hikes or in a city with concert venues? Do you want to drive a car or use public transportation? Ideally, your college years will be a time that offers you the freedom to explore new places, start new hobbies, and meet new people.

What would life look like after graduation? According to Emsi, a labor market data company, where you attend college dramatically affects where you live after you've earned your degree. Sixty-one percent of community college students stay within 50 miles of their school. For state university grads, that number drops to 40 percent, with a large majority staying within state lines. Graduates of elite institutions tend to migrate to large cities. When considering postgraduate study, networking connections, and career choices, it's important to consider if the college is located somewhere you want to live long-term or if you are likely to move somewhere else after receiving your diploma.

All of these questions point to the quality of life which is often overlooked during the decision-making process. Loving a variety of options is a great problem to have, but wise counsel from your family, academic advisors, and trusted friends can steer you in the right direction and narrow the field to help you find the best choice.

But when it comes to making that final decision, you are the only one who will know what's right for you. Choosing the right college can be overwhelming, but it can also be a fun, defining moment that allows you to reflect on who you've become and who you want to be.

Decoding the Fine Print FINANCIAL AID EXPLAINED

the big pain that pays off

FAFSA (FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT

AID): Required form for any federal financial aid. Submit as early as October 1 of senior year. Gather tax returns, bank statements, and family income information. Renewal required annually.

FAFSA'S FANCY COUSIN WHO ASKS ALL THE QUESTIONS " CSS PROFILE: Additional financial aid form required by many private colleges.

More detailed than FAFSA, includes questions about home equity, medical expenses, and business assets. Check if your schools need it.

EXPECTED FAMILY CONTRIBUTION (EFC):

Formula-determined amount your family can theoretically contribute to college costs annually. Based on income, assets, and family size. Key factor in financial aid packages.

good GRADES good \$5\$ MERIT AID: Scholarships awarded based on academic achievement, test scores, or special talents—not financial need. Often renewable if you maintain a certain GPA. Check each school's automatic qualification requirements.

NEED-BASED AID: Financial assistance determined by your family's ability to pay. Calculated by subtracting your EFC from total cost of attendance. Can include grants, loans, and work-study opportunities.

COST OF ATTENDANCE:

Total yearly cost including tuition, room, board, books, supplies, transportation, and personal expenses. Each school calculates this differently. Remember, the listed price isn't always what you'll pay.

GRANT: Financial aid that doesn't need repayment.
Can come from the federal government (Pell Grants), state programs, or individual colleges. Often based on financial need or specific criteria.

SUBSIDIZED VS.
UNSUBSIDIZED: In

subsidized loans, the government pays interest while you're in school. With unsubsidized, interest accumulates immediately. Both have lower rates than private loans.

et's get real for a minute: you're about to start one of the biggest adventures of your life. Whether you're moving across the country or commuting from home, college is a fresh start. A clean slate. The good news? Everyone else in your freshman class is in the exact same boat. They're all wondering how to make friends, pick the right classes, and avoid getting lost on campus. So let's set you up for as much success as possible.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Friendship isn't a race. Those first few weeks, you'll see people forming groups at lightning speed, and you might feel pressure to lock in your friend group immediately. Take a breath. Some of those insta-friends will last, and others will fade as naturally and as quickly as they formed. Quality connections take time.

Start with your built-in communities. Your residence hall, study groups within your major, campus ministries, and student organizations are all filled with people who share at least one thing in common with you. Even better? They're all designed to help freshmen connect.

One that connects to what you love to do (sports, arts, service, faith groups)

This gives you both career connections and fun outlets. Plus, it helps you meet people with different perspectives who share one of your interests.

MORE THAN JUST CLASSES

College isn't just about learning subjects-it's about learning how you learn. Your freshman year is the perfect time to experiment with different study methods, note-taking styles, and time management strategies.

And here's a secret: That first semester is when professors expect you to be figuring things out. They build in extra office hours, schedule study sessions, and often assign peer mentors specifically for freshmen. Take advantage of this built-in support system while everyone else is too nervous to try. You'll be surprised how many doors open simply because you showed up and asked for help.

This is the time to make a bold move. Sit in the front row of at least one class, visit your professor during office hours, even if you're doing well in the class, or approach that acquaintance in your math class to form a study group. These small steps can lead to mentorship opportunities, research positions, or simply better understanding of the material.

FAITH AND GROWTH

Your faith journey in college is yours to shape. Maybe you've been in the same church your whole life, or maybe you're still figuring out what you believe. Either way, freshman year is a chance to explore and deepen your faith on your own terms.

The beautiful thing about college ministry is that it comes in all shapes and sizes. You might find your place in a huge worship gathering that feels like a concert or in a small Bible study that meets in someone's dorm room with hot coffee and honest conversations. Try both. Some weeks you might need the energy of a crowd, and other weeks you might need the comfort of a smaller circle. Your spiritual life doesn't have to look like anyone else's to be real and meaningful.

And don't feel pressured to have it all figured out. Look for spaces that feel welcoming, not judgmental. Connect with others who are asking similar questions. Doubt and curiosity can strengthen your faith, not weaken it.

NOTES ON SPIRITUAL GROWTH DURING THE FIRST YEAR

- 1 Your faith will be challenged-not just by others, but by your own questions. This isn't a crisis; it's growth. The strongest foundations are built on honest questions and authentic seeking.
- 2 Find your Sunday rhythm early. Whether it's a campus ministry, local church, or both, giving yourself a few weeks to church-hop helps you find your fit before midterms hit.
- 3 That random midnight conversation about God with your roommate might teach you more than a semester of theology class.
- 4 Prayer doesn't have to look like it did at home. Some find God in chapel, others in nature walks, others in journaling. Let your spiritual life expand in new directions.
- 5 You can keep in touch with your home church, but don't let it hold you back from putting down new spiritual roots.
- 6 Those moments when you feel most alone? Find out what they are showing you about yourself.
- 7 It's okay to try different spiritual practices. Contemplative prayer, fasting, meditation, service projects-college is the time to figure out how you most enjoy connecting with God.
- 8 The campus ministry that all your friends love might not be where you thrive, and that's okay. God works through many styles and communities.
- 9 When you're stressed about exams or relationships or your future, remember: Some of the best prayers are just honest conversations with God in between classes.
- 10 Your faith is like a plant being repotted. There might be some shock at first, but this new soil could help you grow in ways you never expected.

THE FUTURE FACTOR

Everyone will ask about your major and your plans. Here's the truth: It's completely okay to be undecided, to change your mind, or to have multiple possible futures. Your freshman year is about exploration.

Take classes that interest you, even if they're outside your major. Talk to upperclassmen about their internships. Ask your professors about their career paths. You might be surprised to learn how many successful people completely changed direction during college.

Your curiosity should act as a compass, not a map. A map shows you one fixed route, but a compass helps you navigate while leaving room for discovery. Maybe you love both art and chemistry-there might be a fascinating career combining both that you haven't even heard of yet (medical illustrator, here we go!). Your career center, academic advisors, and professors can help you explore these intersections. Sometimes the most interesting paths are the less obvious ones.

REMEMBER THIS

College isn't about becoming a completely different person-it's about becoming more fully yourself. You don't have to abandon who you were in high school, but you get to decide which parts of yourself you want to grow.

Some days will feel overwhelming. Some days will feel absolutely perfect. Most days will be somewhere in between. That's normal. That's college.

Keep your mind open, your faith active, and your heart ready for new experiences. Ask for help when you need it. Offer help when you can give it. Take photos, but don't forget to put your phone down and really live the moments.

Welcome to college. You've got this.

THE LITTLE THINGS THAT MATTER

Keep a regular sleep schedule-yes, even on weekends.

Learn where and how to do laundry before you run out of clean clothes.

Find your study spots early (both the quiet ones and the social ones).

Get to know your academic advisor. Advisors are there to help you succeed.

Save the phone number for campus security in your contacts.

Find your stress-relief activity, whether that's the gym, chapel, art studio, or a hiking trail.

Figure out the campus shuttle schedule or parking rules before your first week of class.

Learn which dining hall serves what you like best and when the lines are shortest.



he scariest thing about blank pages is also the most beautiful thing about them: They can become anything. As you stand on the edge of your college years, you're holding a pen, and the story ahead is yours to write.

This isn't about writing a perfect story. Perfect stories are boring. The best stories-

the ones worth reading and worth living-have plot twists and character development and, yes, even a few chapters you might wish you could edit later. But every single one is authentic.

The first step in writing your story is to know your narrator. After all, you're not just any character. You're fearfully and wonderfully made, with purpose and potential written into your very DNA.

Understanding yourself, your values, your boundaries, and your non-negotiables isn't self-absorption. It's self-preservation. It's the difference between writing your own story and starring in someone else's. When you know what matters to you, decisions become clearer. Not easier, necessarily, but clearer.

Maybe you've spent years being the character others wanted you to be: the straight-A student your parents bragged about, the athlete your coach saw such potential in, the faithful friend everyone counted on. Those aren't bad roles, but are they the only roles you want to play?

College is your chance to decide which parts of your current character you want to keep and which parts you're ready to revise. You get to choose your supporting cast, your setting, your major plot points. Want to trade your lifetime of soccer for soul-searching through art? That's your call. Thinking about switching your business major to education because teaching feels more right? You can do that.



consequences. Every plot twist you write will ripple through future chapters. That's not meant to frighten you-it's meant to free you. When you actively choose your path rather than passively accepting others' choices for you, you're more equipped to handle the results, whatever they may be.

MAKING CHOICES THAT MATTER

So how do you start embracing your role as author?

Learn to check in with yourself, and God, regularly. How do you feel after spending time with certain friends? Which classes energize you, and which drain you? What makes you lose track of time? Where do you sense God's peace in your decisions? These insights reveal patterns about what truly matters to you and perhaps glimpses of your calling.

Build your support network thoughtfully. Find mentors who ask you good questions instead of just giving answers. Connect with friends who encourage growth rather than compliance. Create space between receiving advice and making decisions. You can be grateful for others' input while still choosing differently.

Accept that first drafts are messy. You'll make the wrong call. You'll trust people who disappoint you. You'll chase opportunities that don't pan out. This isn't failure; it's editing. Every wrong choice helps you clarify the right ones.

Remember that all good stories have conflict. The moments that challenge you most-that seemingly awful roommate, that failed class, that broken relationship-often become the chapters that shape you most. Don't skip them. Don't hide from them. Learn from them.

Most importantly, keep writing. Even on the days when you feel like you've lost the plot, when you're not sure if you're making the right choices, or when it seems like everyone else has their story figured out. Your story won't look like anyone else's because it's not supposed to.

You are now the main character and the author. You get to decide what success looks like, what relationships are worth keeping, what dreams are worth chasing. You get to choose when to follow convention and when to create your own rules. And though you're the author of your choices, you're also part of a greater story. Your unique gifts, passions, and even your struggles serve a purpose beyond yourself.

SO WRITE BOLDLY. WRITE HONESTLY.

Because in the end, the best stories aren't the ones that please the most people-they're the ones that stay true to their author's voice.
