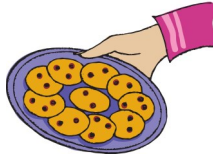

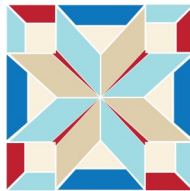

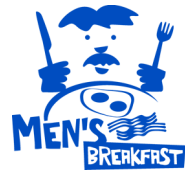

Christmas is coming and Zion will once again collect items for the Homme Home Youth Christmas Gift Collection Nov. 13—Dec. 11.



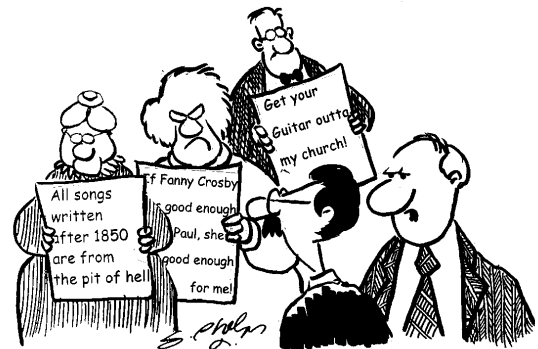
