Our confirmation class has 22 students this year and we are serving a light supper on Wednesdays at 5pm for them, their parents, mentors, and you!



Zion's Quilters are Collecting Personal Care Kits Supplies during Lent!

Each year as the quilters are busy every Tuesday making quilts to send to Lutheran World Relief (LWR), we also gather supplies to make Personal Care Kits to send. In October 2022 we were able to assemble 40 Personal Care Kits with your help. Thank you!

The supplies needed for each Kit:

- One (1) light-weight bath-size towel (20"x40" to 52"x27").
- Two (2) or three (3) bath-size bars of soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping, no mini or hotel size bars.
- One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging.
- One sturdy comb. There are many different types of hair texture, so no picks or fine-toothed combs. Remove packaging.
- One metal nail clippers (attached file optional). Remove packaging.
